



## Management, Training and Socializing.

### Socializing.

Socializing, whether it's with a puppy or an older dog, is all about the environment and stimulus. It is Not about playing with every dog or person they see. Proper socializing to all environments that your dog is going to come across and all the different things your young dog is going to see. A Young dog needs to be able to think in all situations and not just panic or act silly. They also shouldn't run up to every dog or person they see out on a walk.

### Management.

You control the environment you put your dog into. By doing this you are managing your dogs behavior patterns and what he is learning.

E.g. You have your dog on a lead when people come to visit to prevent him from jumping up. Until your dog has learnt not to jump up through training.

Controlling which dogs you allow your dog to interact with.

### Obedience Training.

Obedience training is teaching your dog how to Behave and how to follow commands. Regardless of the environmental distraction. All these behaviors have to be taught through repetition and rewards. And slowly made harder and proofed in different environments.
