ANTICIPATE:

As your dog's teacher you need to try and anticipate anything that might go wrong in their training? We have to know exactly what we want to achieve in every training session we setup. Because if we don't know what we want to achieve, then when something does go wrong, we will be unprepared on how to proceed.

PARTICIPATE:

We need to step in and participate when something goes wrong in our training. We cannot expect our dogs to know what to do without us participating and showing them what we actually want them of them.

COMMUNICATE:

Our communications have to be clearly understood by our dogs. For this to happen we have to be consistent and expect the same result every time so that they learn the appropriate response to the exercise we have set them.

Through clear communication our dogs will learn faster and have a better understanding of what is expected from them in the future.
